



ENROLLMENT

The enrollment request period for incoming freshmen begins in January of a student's eighth-grade year. The lottery is held in early April and requests submitted after that date are added to the wait list in the order received. The request form is available online and from all middle school counselors and main office staff.

Beginning in the fall of each year, Delta representatives provide additional information to eighth-grade students and parents at middle school visits, parent information nights and open house events.

ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES:

- Eligible for promotion to the ninth grade.
- Live within the Kennewick, Pasco, or Richland School District

- Completion of a simple enrollment request form. Students requesting enrollment are selected through a random lottery/wait process. New enrollment requests for tenth grade are dependent on space availability and determined on a case-by-case basis.
- Because of the unique nature of the program at Delta, new students will only be enrolled in their freshmen and sophomore years.

LOCATION

Delta High School is located in the Richland central business district at the updated Columbia Basin College campus. The campus is adjacent to the Richland Public Library and within walking distance of medical facilities, the federal building, restaurants, the Columbia River, and the Richland Community Center. The transit hub is one block away, and regular school day transportation is provided by students' home school districts.
